DISASTERS: PRAYING FOR OTHERS

Without repeating the traumatic incidents in Sydney last week, as followers of the way of Jesus Christ we offer prayer for all affected directly and indirectly and we reinforce our commitment to peace and justice. Usually we do not know those people personally; but on this occasion, family members of St David's parishioners were at Bondi Junction as the event unfolded (no names mentioned here).

Also, anniversaries of tragedies are sometimes still noted: on this day in 1979, a bus from Brisbane Girls' Grammar School crashed, killing 2 children and an adult couple whose children were orphaned. Several parishioners remain in contact with survivors, and some were working in the hospital that received the injured. The Lord be with you, and them, and us all.

CHURCH REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE

As previously informed, the church building was closed during the week after Easter for floor, wall and ceiling work, finally repairing "rain bomb" damage from February 2022.

Repair of the roof including asbestos tile replacement will follow soon; it is unlikely to cause major disruption, but information will be given when necessary. Both of these projects are funded from insurance payments received, albeit after a long wait and an equally long wait for approved tradespeople to be available; with approval by Parish Council, consultants from the Diocese have overseen the contracts together with Church Warden Karen Green.

A NEW ASSISTANT BISHOP FOR OUR DIOCESE

Archbishop Jeremy Greaves recently announced the appointment of The Reverend Sarah Plowman to be the new Assistant Bishop for the Northern Region of our Diocese.

Sarah is known to many of you and remains friends with some of you from a period of ministry here many years ago when in training and newly ordained. She was also a guest preacher here last year.

Currently she has overseen the Formation of all prospective and current Ordinands – people studying and preparing for Ordination – based at St Francis Theological College, Milton, and previously has served in parish ministry and school chaplaincy. Her Consecration as Bishop will take place in the Cathedral on Friday evening 28 June. More information will follow. We rejoice with her and our diocese, and pray for all our bishops and other leaders.
