## To the people of St David's Church

The combined service last Sunday was seemingly enjoyed by everyone – a fuller church than usual, concluded within 45 minutes and a good tea to follow. We sang well with the accompaniment of the keyboard, using pre-recorded music and with more voices than usual. Several people have suggested we have more combined services from time to time.

It was also very good to have a significant number of people attending the Parish Meeting. The overwhelming positive response to go ahead with the Proposals was very gratifying. Without having called for it, I received almost 20 additional verbal or emailed requests from people unavoidably away thus unable to attend the meeting, wanting to offer full and unequivocal support to the Proposals.

Timelines were not stressed at the meeting, as we wanted to avoid any sense of people feeling "pushed" to make a decision. For that reason, towards the conclusion of the meeting we clearly asked people to vote NO if they were opposed overall and/or if they wanted more time and another similar meeting in about a month's time (as also mentioned in the Newsletter sent to all on Friday 12 April). That was not supported, and the overwhelming response was YES, go ahead!

Our hopes are for our Proposal to be placed before the FDSC – Finance and Diocesan Services Commission – in early May. The FDSC includes the bishops, several archdeacons, and many lay people with relevant financial, property and general parish and ministry experience. Documentation was required to be submitted by this past Friday 26 April, and the Diocesan Property Team we have been working with were ready to go ahead with that.

I write this before the ANZAC Day public holiday in order to print before the parish office closes for the week. Karen Green and I will be meeting with Bishop John Roundhill and our Archdeacon, Bronwyn Pagram this Wednesday afternoon. Further information will be conveyed when appropriate, and also in a subsequent Parish Newsletter.

### **CHURCH REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE**

As previously informed, the church building was closed during the week after Easter for floor, wall and ceiling work, finally repairing "rain bomb" damage from February 2022.

Repair of the roof including asbestos tile replacement will follow soon; it is unlikely to cause major disruption, but information will be given when necessary. Both of these projects are funded from insurance payments received, albeit after a long wait and an equally long wait for approved tradespeople to be available; with approval by Parish Council, consultants from the Diocese have overseen the contracts together with Church Warden Karen Green. **TERMITE UPDATE**: We are grateful that most of the building works to repair the water damage sustained in the church during the 2022 rain event has now been completed. While the scaffolding required for these repairs was in place we were able to undertake further termite checks of our building - in areas previously inaccessible due to the height of our ceilings. Unfortunately, more termites have been found and works are now under to treat the areas and finally rid our building of these tenacious pests. Disruption to Sunday Services should not occur.
