EASTER BLANKET COLLECTION

We are again collecting blankets & sleeping bags for "rough sleepers" in our city, cared for by volunteers at St John's Cathedral & the Diocese Offices in Ann Street, Brisbane city centre. Please bring warm sleeping items to the church over the coming weeks of our Easter Season; they can be new, or used items in good condition. After Pentecost on Sunday 19 May, all donated items will be taken to the Diocese for distribution. Thank you.

GROCERY COLLECTION – ONGOING – DISTRIBUTION VIA CAREFORCE

The need is constant. Every week, parish volunteers deliver what we have brought to the church to St Hugh's Anglican Parish, Inala for distribution through their Careforce Centre. They are authorised through Anglicare and follow state and federal requirements for distribution of financial aid (provided by government funding, not by us), with provision of food and other household necessities being provided by communities such as us.

Pamphlets in the church entrance offer reminders of what is best to provide and give details including online links for those who need to know more.

PARISH MEETING ON SUNDAY 21 APRIL

ONE SERVICE AT 9.00am followed by PARISH MEETING at 10.15am.

The hoped-for meeting referred to at our AGM in February and in subsequent publications can now take place as noted above. Parish Council (PC) awaits the final "dotting of i's and crossing of t's" from the Diocesan Property Team after a successful but long-delayed meeting with Brisbane City Council town planning personnel.

A committee of PC has worked with this and reported back from time to time, and a Special PC Meeting will be held on Thursday 11 April. The monthly PC Meeting

on 25 March agreed unanimously to hold a Parish Meeting on Sunday 21 April, giving sufficient time for preparations beforehand.

It is open to all parishioners but is not a public meeting thus not one to which family, friends or local neighbours who are not parishioners can be invited.

The Communion Service will begin at 9.00am. Norma Graham will be our preacher for the day (Gospel theme: Jesus the Good Shepherd), and it will be shorter than usual concluding at 9.45am. After Morning Tea, the meeting will begin at 10.15am.

The intention is to make a First Presentation to the Parish of property and finance proposals to ensure the long-term sustainability of St David's. If you did not read the Wardens' and Treasurer's Statements from February and would like a copy emailed to you, please ask Rev Nic or Karen Green.

A NEW ASSISTANT BISHOP FOR OUR DIOCESE

Archbishop Jeremy Greaves recently announced that he had appointed The Reverend Sarah Plowman to be a new Assistant Bishop in our Diocese, with responsibility for the Northern Region (for which he was previously responsible).

Sarah is known to many of you and remains friends with a few of you, from a period of ministry work here several years ago when in training and newly ordained, and she was a guest preacher here last year.

Currently she has overseen the Formation of all prospective and current Ordinands – people studying and preparing for Ordination in our Diocese – and is based at St Francis Theological College, Milton. Previously she has been in parish ministry and school chaplaincy. Her Consecration as bishop will take place at Diocesan Synod mid-year; more information will follow. We rejoice with her and our diocese, and pray for all our bishops and other leaders.
